

Paarl Hebrew Kindergarten Celebrates Chanukah.

Scenes of great enthusiasm were witnessed on Sunday morning, 2nd December, in the well-filled Talmud Torah Hall, Paarl, when the first Hebrew Kindergarten concert took place on the occasion of Chanukah.

The programme consisted of three parts: the first depicted a garden scene in which the children acted as flowers, trees, birds, butterflies, etc. The costumes, decoration and stage were very impressive and showed admirable taste on the part of the teacher, Miss Kluk, who was responsible for the production. The second was a very impressive Chanukah scene where one-half of the children were dressed as "Svivonim," the other as "Neirot." The third scene related to the celebration of Sabbath.

The various scenes moved the audience to tears of joy and clearly showed the wonderful progress the children had made during the seven months' existence of the "Gan" under the very able direction of the Kindergarten Mistress, Miss M. Kluk, M.A. Particularly good were the recitations ren-

dered by Sybil Berman, Bertha Tannenber, Malcolm Cohen and Ruth Back. The prize for the best rendered item was awarded to little three-years-old Bella Hurwitz.

During the interval Mr. Lazar, the Principal of the Paarl Hebrew School, spoke on Chanukah explaining the importance of Hebrew education during the kindergarten age. He thought the community owed a debt of gratitude to Miss Kluk for her love and devotion to her work and to the Jewish child. It is thanks to her that the Kindergarten was such a great success. Mr. Lazar emphasised the necessity of continuing to educate the children in Hebrew even after their kindergarten age had passed.

Mr. Myers, the Chairman of the Kindergarten, likewise spoke on the great achievement of the Kindergarten and of the new life and Jewish spirit the little tots had brought into the homes of their parents. He thanked his committee and Mrs. J. Klitzner, who assisted at the piano the whole time having thus contributed a great deal to the success of the concert.

Particular mention must be made of Dr. Max Cohen who painted the decorations for the scenes, and helped in the technical arrangements.

The Chairman presented Miss M. Kluk and Miss Ziporah Jankelewitz, the staff of the Kindergarten, and Mrs. J. Klitzner, each with a beautiful basket of everlastings in appreciation of their work in connection with the concert.

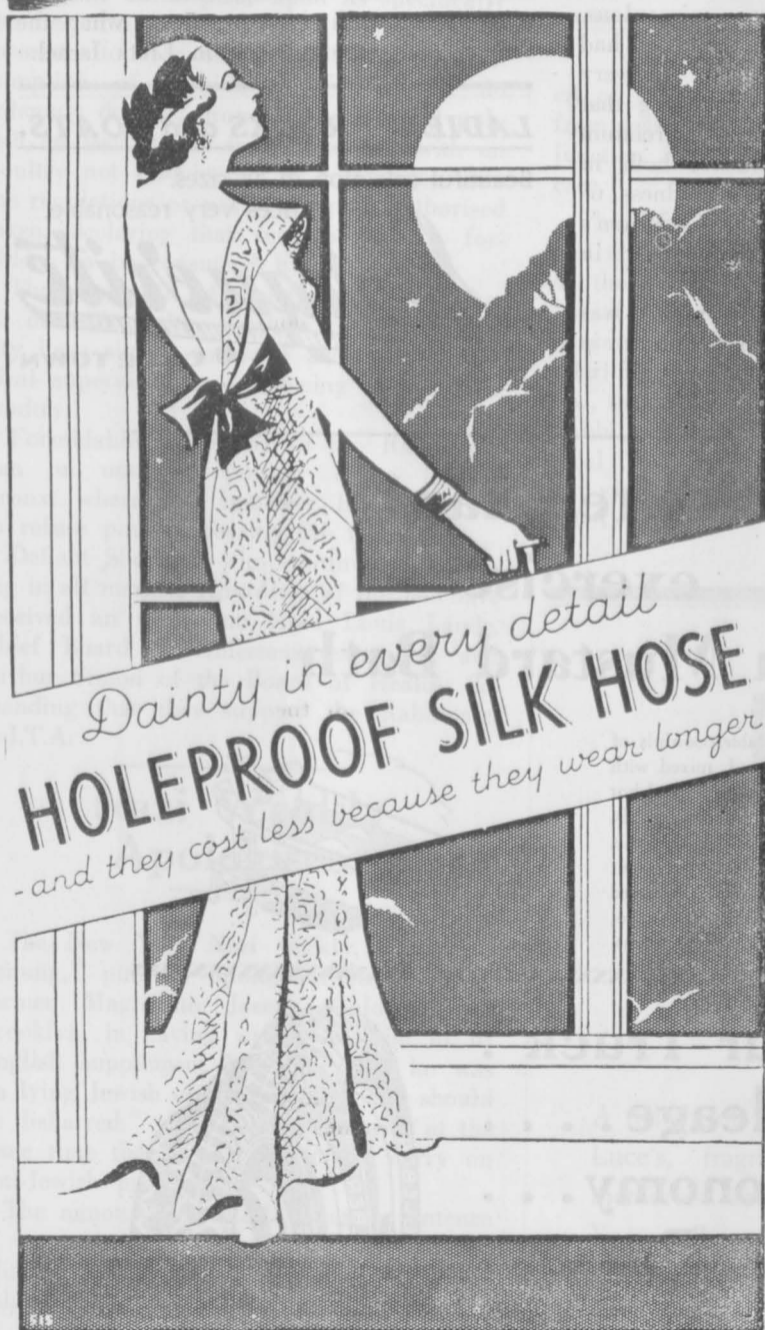
Mr. Myers distributed Chanukah presents amongst the children and the eventful morning concluded with the singing of Hatikvah.
