A.B.C. Symphony Orchestra

Professor Kirby as Guest Conductor.

The guest-conductor at the seventeenth fortnightly concert given by the African Broadcasting Symphony Orchestra on Tuesday evening last at the Jewish Guild Memorial Hall, was Professor P. R. Kirby, of the University of the Witwatersrand.

The programme was chiefly of Russian music excepting the Rhapsody "Brigg Fair" by Delius. The most attractive item of the evening was undoubtedly the symphony poem, "Stenka Razin," by Glazounov. The work is full of subtle orchestral effects and the orchestra under the baton of Mr. Kirby, rose to the occasion and gave a remarkably fine performance. The overture from "Prince Igor" by Borodine, was given with a fine vigour and the programme concluded with "Capriccio Espagnole" by Rimsky-Korsakov. This is one of the most colourful musical compositions ever written and the orchestra got over every ounce of volume and brilliancy. The rendering of this item aroused the enthusiasm and applause of the large and discerning audience.
